Requirements: Dogs must not be aggressive toward people or other dogs! Must show proof of vaccinations.

Introduction to Agility: This is a class for dogs who have never done agility. It is designed to give dogs exposure to the sport in a safe and controlled setting. This class is mostly conducted “on-leash”. Please bring a 6 foot leash and buckle collar to class. Dogs will be introduced to obstacles at a low height, learning targeting and foundation work.

Agility I: For dogs who have completed an introductory class.

Agility II: This is a class for dogs who have completed Agility I, have been exposed to all the obstacles and are now starting to work on courses, or with permission of the instructor.

AGILITY I and II combined: Weds. Nov.9, Nov.30, and all Dec.,7:15-8:15 pm
This class is nearly full- students have already trained on all obstacles, tho may be a bit weak on some, but have been exposed to several different crosses and other handling skills. This is also a six week class. Call the instructor to join this class.

Fee for all class sessions: \$80 for the six week series.

Agility classes are held in our indoor arena on clean sand. Please dress accordingly!
