



# OBEDIENCE CLASSES



*for dogs and puppies*

## **BEGINNING OBEDIENCE- DOGS AND PUPPIES OVER 4 MOS.:**

This class is for both puppies and adult dogs. It is for dogs whose manners need improving- they jump on people, pull on the leash, etc. NOT for dogs with aggression problems. This class teaches basic control and answers questions about day-to-day management of your dog. We will work on *sit, stay, down, come* and *heel*. Please bring a nylon or leather leash to the first class, six feet in length is preferred- no chain or retractable leashes. We will be teaching this class using flat buckle or choke collars, not halter-type control devices. Instructor: Lindsay Strutt This class meets for 4 weeks; the fee is \$50. Class meets Monday nights, 7-8 p.m.

## **ADVANCED OBEDIENCE:**

Continuation of beginning obedience. Requires a 3 min. sit and a 5 min. down with the handler across the room, or permission of instructor. Instructor: Lindsay Strutt This class meets for 4 weeks, the fee is \$50. Class meets Monday nights, 8-9 p.m.

*Lindsay Strutt has been teaching obedience for more than 30 years. She has titled many purebred dogs of several different breeds in AKC competitions, all the way through the highest level, Utility. She is now working in rally obedience. Lindsay is also a professional handler of show dogs and an all-breed dog groomer.*
